01 Friday: Arrival & Village Vibes

3:00 p.m. – Check-in at the Villas

Settle into the [Villas at Snowmass Club](#), offering one- to three-bedroom residences with private patios and full kitchens.

You can skip the rental car; the [Snowmass Village Shuttle](#) (Route 3) provides free service directly to the Snowmass Club until 9:50 PM, leaving the Club at :05 and :35 past the hour

6:30 p.m. – Dinner: Upscale Latin or Casual Slopeside

For an upscale start, head to [Toro](#) at the Viceroy. Based on 2026 recommendations, the lobster wonton tacos, braised beef baos, and the Cusco chicken are the stars of the menu. For a more casual vibe, try the new Après Deck on the Snowmass Mall.

8:30 p.m. – Evening Fire Pits

Cap off your first night with table-side guacamole and a prickly pear margarita by the fire pits at [Venga Venga](#). If you still have energy, [The Flower Shop](#) in Base Village offers a curated karaoke experience to kick off the weekend.

02 Saturday: Mountain Adventure

9:00 a.m. – The "Valley Classic" Hike

Tackle the [Rim Trail](#). This 7.88-mile sinuous singletrack is a "Roaring Fork Valley Classic". While not technically challenging, it is rated Advanced due to steep climbs and aerobic demands. **Pro Tip:** Follow the recommended South to North direction for the most stunning views of the village and surrounding peaks. **Prefer a guided pace?** The [ACES Wildflower Walk](#) departs daily from the Snowmass Mall at 10:00 AM.

12:30 p.m. – Lunch with a View

Ride the Elk Camp Gondola to [Elk Camp Restaurant](#) for an elevated market-style lunch. Enjoy a bowl of grass-fed beef chili or a custom organic salad on the deck.

2:00 p.m. – Adrenaline at Lost Forest

Spend your afternoon at the [Lost Forest adventure park](#).

- Breathtaker Alpine Coaster: A 7-to-9-minute thrill ride through the trees.
- Treeline Trial: A challenge course featuring rappels, ziplines, and bridges. 2026 Pricing: A Base Ticket is \$84, while the Treeline Ticket is \$121. (Note: The Canopy Run Zipline is closed for the 2026 season).

7:00 p.m. – Saturday Night Highlights

Check the 2026 calendar for marquee Saturday events.

- [Night Swimming and Hot Tubs](#): Guests staying at the Villas at Snowmass Club have exclusive evening access to the Club's 19,000-square-foot athletic center, which includes heated outdoor swimming pools and hot tubs with views of Mt. Daly.
- Art Strolls: The [Snowmass Art Walk](#) consists of curated, self-guided loops featuring public art, sculptures, and murals throughout the village that can be enjoyed at your own pace as the sun sets.
- Bowling and Billiards: [105 Pizza & Bowl](#) (also known as Snowmass Lanes & Lounge) features six bowling lanes, professional billiard and foosball tables, a dart board, and 300-inch projection screens surrounded by comfortable leather couches.





03 Sunday: The Slow Morning

10:30 AM – Summit-Side Brunch Experience

Sunday Brunch at Elk Camp. This summit-side buffet features breakfast classics paired with champagne pours, mimosas, or bloody marys and “big sky” views.

1:00 PM – Golf or Spa Relaxation

Before departing, choose your pace:

- Golf: Play the [Jim Engh signature links-style course at the Snowmass Club](#). Villa guests can access a preferred rate of \$158 for tee times between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM.
- Spa: Visit the [Viewline Spa by RAKxa](#) for a 50-minute Personalized Massage or Facial (\$275). Alternatively, enjoy the 19,000 sq. ft. athletic center and pools included with your Villa stay.

3:00 PM – A Final Stroll

Take a leisurely, self-guided walk on the Snowmass Art Walk, exploring curated sculptures and murals throughout the village before heading home.

2026 Dining “Must-Try” Dish List

Toro Kitchen & Lounge

Located inside the Viceroy Resort, this upscale destination offers contemporary Latin cuisine inspired by traditions from across Central and South America.

Lobster wonton tacos, braised beef baos, Cusco chicken, and the “la bomba” dessert.

Aurum

A sophisticated yet casual seasonal New American restaurant in Base Village with “alpine refinement” and highly rated cinematic views.

Crispy curried cauliflower, Rocky Mountain trout filet, New York steak frites, and warm chocolate chip cookies.

The Stew Pot

The oldest restaurant in Snowmass, this no-frills mall staple is famous for its rotating selection of fresh homemade fare.

Habanero pork stew and the lamb stew special with mashed potatoes.

New Belgium Ranger Station

A chill brewpub on the Snowmass Mall featuring New Belgium craft beers on tap.

Baked pretzel rolls with cheese fondue or hazelnut chocolate dip, and the chicken Parmesan hoagie.

Venga Venga

A casual slopeside Mexican cantina by Chef Richard Sandoval on the Snowmass Mall, featuring an outdoor patio with fire pits and panoramic mountain views

Table-side guacamole, prickly pear margaritas, and sizzling fajitas or street tacos.

Villa guest rate is \$250 per person after 1:00 p.m., but you can book a preferred rate of \$158 for slots between 12:00 and 1:00 p.m.

Viewline Spa by RAKxa

Personalized massages or facials start at \$275 for 50 minutes

7.88 miles, rated Advanced for steep climbs; travel South to North for the best views

Shuttle Transportation

Route 3 (Villas)

Runs every 30 minutes until 9:50 p.m.; departs the Snowmass Club at :05 and :35 past the hour

Route 4 (Mall/Base Village)

Runs every 20 minutes until 8:00 p.m.
